The Holy Communion

All are welcome to receive the sacrament, kneeling or standing at the altar rail. Due to health and safety concerns during the pandemic, we are receiving communion in bread and not using the common cup. If you wish to receive communion in both kinds, we are using individual small cups for this purpose. There is a cruet of water on a table by the baptismal font where the cup can be rinsed and consumed or poured into the ground outside to properly dispose of the remaining sacrament. If you choose not to receive communion, you are welcome to come to the altar rail for a blessing. Rice wafers are available for those needing gluten free. Please let the priest know.
